

**ORDINANCE 2009-954**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WAITSBURG, WASHINGTON, ALLOWING  
BUSINESSES ALONG MAIN STREET TO HAVE EXPANDED DISPLAYS AND SALES  
OF MERCHANDISE UPON ISSUANCE OF PERMIT**

**WHEREAS**, owners of businesses would benefit from being able to display and sell merchandise on sidewalk areas in the Main Street corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, there may be times where business owners may wish to have displays or sales more extensive than those allowed under the existing sidewalk display and sale ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, to the extent such display events may be held without placing public health, safety, or welfare at risk, the City of Waitsburg desires to allow businesses which operate along Main Street to have the option for more extensive sales or displays upon meeting certain conditions;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Waitsburg do ordain as follows:

SECTION 6.11.010 of the Waitsburg Municipal Code shall be amended and shall read as follows:

Chapter 11 – Temporary Special Events

6.11.010. Definition. "Temporary special event" means any display, sale, fair, show, race, fun-run, parade, dance, festival, or other entertainment or celebration, which event is to be held in whole or in part upon publicly owned property and/or public rights-of-way, or if held wholly upon private property, will nevertheless affect or impact the ordinary and normal use by the general public of public property or public rights-of-way within the vicinity of such event.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
