

RESOLUTION NO. 2011 – 586

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAITSBURG REQUESTING
THE WALLA COUNTY AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR
APPROVAL OF THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION FLOOD
CONTROL BONDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Waitsburg desires to hold a special election for approval of the issuance of general obligation flood control bonds;

WHEREAS, RCW 29A.04.330(2) provides that the County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections, upon request in the form of a resolution of the governing body of a city, town, or district, presented to the Auditor prior to the proposed election date, may call a special election;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to request that the Walla Walla County Auditor conduct a special election on the ballot measure as described below;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAITSBURG,
WASHINGTON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

The Walla Walla County Auditor is requested to hold and conduct a special election on November 8, 2011, which is the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, pursuant to RCW 29A.04.330(2) on the following ballot measure:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAITSBURG APPROVED RESOLUTION NO. 2011-586 CONCERNING A PROPOSITION TO FINANCE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS RELATED TO FLOOD PROTECTION FROM COPPEI CREEK. THIS PROPOSITION WOULD AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO PAY THE COSTS OF A FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT ALONG COPPEI CREEK INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION OF FLOOD WALLS, LEVEE AND OTHER FLOOD PROTECTION ACTIVITIES; TO ISSUE NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS MATURING WITHIN A MAXIMUM TERM OF 20 YEARS TO PAY FOR SUCH FLOOD CONTROL AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; AND LEVY ANNUAL EXCESS PROPERTY TAX LEVIES TO PAY AND RETIRE SUCH BONDS.

The election shall be conducted by mail ballot; and the procedures and forms to conduct the special election by mail ballot shall be prescribed by the Walla Walla County Auditor in accordance with RCW Title 29A and chapter 434-250 WAC.
